Nearly 10 acres have just been conserved on the Missisquoi River in Enosburg Falls.

7.33 acres have been donated by the Vermont River Conservancy to the Village of Enosburg Falls as a River Access Park that provides fishing access to trophy trout waters and a portage on the Northern Forest Canoe Trail. Two one-acre parcels with spectacular views of Jay Peak were conveyed to the Franklin / Grand Isle chapter of Habitat for Humanity.
